Work is wrapping up on the pump room in the new addition. Testing of the system has been completed and we're awaiting Maine Fire's return to have the system go live.

Engine 371 is still in the shop. We haven't received any updates on the progress in about three weeks. There have been several delays due to parts and wrong parts being shipped. We hope to have it back home and in service soon.

We're still looking for more people from around town to join our team. If interested, please stop by the station on one of our training nights, see what we're about, and meet the crew. We meet every Wednesday at the Dedham Fire Station at 6:00PM.
